In January 2023 I started my first role as a Junior Web Developer / Onsite Technician and am now flourishing in the tech sector as a Full Stack Developer for an eCommerce agency in Birmingham.

Of course, I still have the skills and knowledge I gained as a teacher and put them to use everyday – whether it's helping colleagues with projects, using my interpersonal skills with clients, or effectively managing my time while juggling several builds at the same time.
